- Civic Centre;
- Leisure Centres;

OBJECTIVES

- Establish if there is adequate disabled car parking provision for the population of Hambleton;
- Determine whether the principle of providing free car parking spaces for disabled persons should be extended to all spaces rather than just designated disabled bays.
- Determine whether disabled spaces should be charged for; reviewing why there is currently no charge.
