Subject: TIMING OF MEETINGS

1.0 PURPOSE AND BACKGROUND:

- 1.1 This report asks the Council to consider the start time of its meetings.
- 1.2 It has been our practice to periodically review the start times of meetings and the commencement of a new civic year was considered the right time to do this. To help with this process Members were asked to indicate their preferred time for meetings to commence by specifying all the times that were suitable to them.
- 1.3 Forty Members responded to the survey, 34 Members chose a 10.00am start although 10 indicated that 9.00am or 9.30am would be preferred. Thirty Members opted for a 2.00pm start with 3 indicating a preference for 1.00pm or 1.30pm. Nineteen members chose a start time of 4.30pm and 10 for 6.00pm.
