Olympic Torchbearers after Party

A number of elected members joined the Chairman to welcome, thank and congratulate ten of the District's Olympic Torchbearers at an afternoon event which celebrated the Olympic Torch Relay in Hambleton (and Richmondshire) which was witnessed by an estimated 71,000 people.

We have two Olympic medal winners from Hambleton, Nicola Wilson from Northallerton won a silver in a team equestrian event, and Kat Copeland from Stokesley won gold in the lightweight double sculls, held at the Olympic Rowing Centre in Eton Dorney. Both will be invited as guests of honour to the annual Hambleton Sports Awards to be held in October. Date is to be confirmed.

Tour of France 2016

Hambleton is supporting Welcome to Yorkshire with its "Back Le Bid" campaign to bring the 2016 "Grand Depart", the first three stages of the Tour de France, to Yorkshire. The bid is down to three competitors, Yorkshire, Edinburgh and Venice.
