## HACKNEY CARRIAGE/PRIVATE HIRE LICENSING

### LICENSING AND APPEALS HEARINGS PANEL

#### PROCEDURE

1. The hearing of matters will be less formal than hearings before, for instance, a Magistrates' Court. In particular, strict rules of evidence are not adhered to and information is not provided under oath. Nevertheless, proceedings before the Panel will observe basic rules of natural justice.
2. At the beginning of the hearing the Chairman shall:-
  - ask those present to introduce themselves;
  - explain the procedure;
  - ask the parties whether they wish permission for another person to appear at the hearing.
3. The Panel will consider whether the public should be excluded from all or any part of the hearing. This will only be done if the Panel considers that the public interest in so doing outweighs the public interest in the hearing taking place in public.
4. The Panel will consider requests for permission for other persons to appear at the hearing. Such permission will not be unreasonably withheld.
5. The Chairman will ask the Principal Licensing Officer to outline the background to the case.
6. The hearing shall take the form of a discussion led by the Panel (through the Chairman) and cross-examination shall not be permitted unless the Panel considers that cross-examination is required for it to consider the matter.

7. The Chairman is likely to ask for the views of the parties in the following order:-
  - (a) the applicant/licence holder (including any other persons who have been given permission to participate);
  - (b) any party making representations (including any other persons who have been given permission to participate).
8. The applicant/licence holder will be given the final opportunity to address the Panel.
9. The Panel may exclude disruptive persons.
10. The Panel may adjourn the hearing.
11. The Panel may ask the parties to withdraw so that it can consider its determination. In considering its determination, the Panel may ask its Legal Advisor to provide it with legal and procedural advice. The nature of this advice will be notified to the parties.
12. The Panel will make its determination at the end of the hearing and this will be confirmed in writing.

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### **1.0 SUMMARY**

1.1 Members are asked to consider whether or not to grant an application for the renewal of a private hire vehicle licence.

### **2.0 PROCEDURE**

2.1 The procedure for licensing hearings is attached as an Annex to the Agenda.

### **3.0 LICENCE STATUS**

3.1 Since 1<sup>st</sup> June 2015, Carlton Cars (N Yorks) Ltd have held a private hire vehicle licence (plate number PHV74) in respect of a Volkswagen Passat, vehicle registration mark LR54 FDJ.

3.2 The licence expired on 31<sup>st</sup> May 2017. However, a renewal application was received on 20<sup>th</sup> March 2017 and private hire journeys are authorised between the date of the application and the date of determination. Effectively, the applicant may exercise continuation rights until such time as a decision is made in relation to the renewal.

3.3 On 20<sup>th</sup> March 2017, Carlton Cars (N Yorks) Ltd applied to renew the private hire vehicle licence pertaining to the vehicle. A copy of the application form is attached at **Annex A**.

3.4 All applicants are required to produce the following documents before a licence will be renewed:

- a current MOT Certificate;
- proof that the licensing authority's testing arrangements have been satisfied (i.e. a test paper completed and signed by a Hambleton-based VOSA-accredited testing station); and
- a current vehicle insurance certificate or cover note which includes the carriage of passengers for private hire;

3.5 The applicant has produced the requisite documents listed in 3.4 and copies are attached at **Annex B**. The documents have been accepted and validated by licensing officers.

3.6 The MOT history of the vehicle has been taken from the GOV.UK website and is attached at **Annex C**.

### **4.0 BACKGROUND**

4.1 According to the registration document, the vehicle in question was first registered on 8<sup>th</sup> October 2004 (12 years and 8 months ago).

4.2 The most recent MOT certificate shows that, on 18<sup>th</sup> May 2017, the recorded mileage was 233,872 miles.

4.3 On 2<sup>nd</sup> May 2017, Mr Wrightson (of Carlton Cars) sent an email to the Licensing Team to confirm his intention to refer his application to the Licensing Committee. Mr Wrightson also indicated that any supporting documentation would be presented at the hearing. The email is attached at **Annex D**.

## **5.0 POLICY CONSIDERATIONS**

5.1 In carrying out its licensing functions, the Panel should have regard to the council's Hackney Carriage and Private Hire Licensing Policy.

5.2 In accordance with paragraph 3.2.1 of the policy, the council will generally only grant a licence in respect of a private hire vehicle if it is less than 10 years old at the time of the application. For these purposes, the age of the vehicle shall be taken from the date of first registration. The vehicle in question surpassed this general age limit in October 2014.

5.3 The Licensing Committee approved the adoption of an age policy on 11<sup>th</sup> February 2016 having satisfied itself that it was appropriate to promote public safety, reliability and improved high standards of hackney carriage and private hire services in the district.

5.4 The council's policy can (and is generally likely to) affect the outcome of the decision in most cases and this is entirely lawful. The policy is a means of securing a consistent approach to individual cases.

5.5 Each case must be considered in the light of the policy but not so that the policy automatically determines the outcome<sup>1</sup>.

5.6 According to the minutes of the meeting on 11<sup>th</sup> February 2016, the Licensing Committee acknowledged that the policy allowed exceptions to the general rule by placing a requirement on the licensing authority to consider each application on its individual merits and to depart from the general policy where the specific circumstances of a case justify making an exception.

5.7 The onus is on the applicant to demonstrate that any such exception should be made<sup>2</sup>.

## **6.0 DETERMINATION BY THE PANEL**

6.1 Members are advised to take one of the following steps:

6.1.1 The Panel may conclude that the specific circumstances of the applicant's individual case justify making an exception from the general policy, in which case, the Panel may grant the application; or

6.1.2 The Panel may refuse to renew the licence on the grounds of any reasonable cause.
