HACKNEY CARRIAGE/PRIVATE HIRE LICENSING

LICENSING AND APPEALS HEARINGS PANEL

PROCEDURE

- 1. The hearing of matters will be less formal than hearings before, for instance, a Magistrates' Court. In particular, strict rules of evidence are not adhered to and information is not provided under oath. Nevertheless, proceedings before the Panel will observe basic rules of natural justice.
- 2. At the beginning of the hearing the Chairman shall:-
 - ask those present to introduce themselves;
 - explain the procedure;
 - ask the parties whether they wish permission for another person to appear at the hearing.
- 3. The Panel will consider whether the public should be excluded from all or any part of the hearing. This will only be done if the Panel considers that the public interest in so doing outweighs the public interest in the hearing taking place in public.
- 4. The Panel will consider requests for permission for other persons to appear at the hearing. Such permission will not be unreasonably withheld.
- 5. The Chairman will ask the Principal Licensing Officer to outline the background to the case.
- 6. The hearing shall take the form of a discussion led by the Panel (through the Chairman) and cross-examination shall not be permitted unless the Panel considers that cross-examination is required for it to consider the matter.

- 7. The Chairman is likely to ask for the views of the parties in the following order:-
 - (a) the applicant/licence holder (including any other persons who have been given permission to participate);
 - (b) any party making representations (including any other persons who have been given permission to participate).
- 8. The applicant/licence holder will be given the final opportunity to address the Panel.
- 9. The Panel may exclude disruptive persons.
- 10. The Panel may adjourn the hearing.
- 11. The Panel may ask the parties to withdraw so that it can consider its determination. In considering its determination, the Panel may ask its Legal Advisor to provide it with legal and procedural advice. The nature of this advice will be notified to the parties.
- 12. The Panel will make its determination at the end of the hearing and this will be confirmed in writing.

1.0 **SUMMARY**

1.1 Members are asked to consider whether or not to grant an application for the renewal of a hackney carriage vehicle licence.

2.0 PROCEDURE

2.1 The procedure for licensing hearings is attached as an Annex to the Agenda.

3.0 LICENCE STATUS

- 3.1 Since 18th November 2015, Mr James Armstrong has held a hackney carriage vehicle licence (plate number HC87) in respect of a Mercedes E270 CDI, vehicle registration mark H13 AYP. The licence is due to expire on 31st October 2017.
- 3.2 On 27th July 2017, James Armstrong applied to renew the hackney carriage vehicle licence pertaining to the vehicle. A copy of the application form is attached at **Annex A**.
- 3.3 All applicants are required to produce the following documents before a licence will be renewed:
 - a current MOT Certificate:
 - proof that the licensing authority's testing arrangements have been satisfied (i.e. a test paper completed and signed by a Hambleton-based VOSA-accredited testing station);
 - a current vehicle insurance certificate or cover note which includes the carriage of passengers for private hire;
- 3.4 The applicant has produced the requisite documents listed in 3.3 and copies are attached at **Annexes B, C & D**. The documents have been accepted and validated by licensing officers.
- 3.5 The MOT history of the vehicle has been taken from the GOV.UK website and is attached at **Annex E**.
- 3.6 The most recent MOT certificate shows that, on 24th October 2016, the recorded mileage was 58,157 miles.
- 3.7 According to the registration document, attached at **Annex F**, the vehicle in question was first registered on 6th August 2004 (13 years ago).
- 3.8 On 27th July 2017, Mr Armstrong also provided a record of the service history for the vehicle in question. The record is attached at **Annex G**.

3.9 On 15th February 2017, five months before submitting his application, Mr Armstrong sent a letter to the Licensing Team to support his subsequent application and to provide reasons for the council to grant the licence on the basis of the individual circumstances of his case. Mr Armstrong sent a further letter to the Licensing Team in support of his application on 27th July 2017. Copies of the letters are attached at **Annex H**.

4.0 POLICY CONSIDERATIONS

- 4.1 In carrying out its licensing functions, the Panel should have regard to the council's Hackney Carriage and Private Hire Licensing Policy.
- 4.2 In accordance with paragraph 2.2.1 of the policy, the council will generally only grant a licence in respect of a hackney carriage vehicle if it is less than 10 years old at the time of the application. For these purposes, the age of the vehicle shall be taken from the date of first registration. The vehicle in question surpassed this general age limit in August 2014.
- 4.3 The Licensing Committee approved the adoption of an age policy on 11th February 2016 having satisfied itself that it was appropriate to promote public safety, reliability and improved high standards of hackney carriage and private hire services in the district.
- 4.4 The council's policy can (and is generally likely to) affect the outcome of the decision in most cases and this is entirely lawful. The policy is a means of securing a consistent approach to individual cases.
- 4.5 Each case must be considered in the light of the policy but not so that the policy automatically determines the outcome¹.
- 4.6 According to the minutes of the meeting on 11th February 2016, the Licensing Committee acknowledged that the policy allowed exceptions to the general rule by placing a requirement on the licensing authority to consider each application on its individual merits and to depart from the general policy where the specific circumstances of a case justify making an exception.
- 4.7 The onus is on the applicant to demonstrate that any such exception should be made².

5.0 DETERMINATION BY THE PANEL

- 5.1 Members are advised to take one of the following steps:
 - 5.1.1 The Panel may conclude that the specific circumstances of the applicant's individual case justify making an exception from the general policy, in which case, the Panel may grant the application; or
 - 5.1.2 The Panel may refuse to renew the licence on the grounds of any reasonable cause.


