CA.31 **IMPLEMENTATION OF THE COMMUNITY INFRASTRUCTURE LEVY (CIL)
CHARGING SCHEDULE**

All Wards outside the North York Moors National Park

The subject of the decision:

In April Council agreed the arrangements for implementing Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) in Hambleton. This allowed for direct payment of CIL as a charge or by payment in kind by donating land but did not consider payment in kind through direct provision of infrastructure. This report sought consideration of an amended to the CIL Charging Schedule to allow for direct provision of infrastructure to be included within the Council's Regulation 123 list in lieu of a financial payment.

Alternative options considered:

The reason for the decision:

To comply with Regulation 123 of the Community Infrastructure Levy Regulations 2010.
