## 1.0 Purpose and Background

- 1.1 Following consideration by Cabinet at its meeting held on Tuesday, 7 July 2020, this report asks the Deputy Chief Executive to consider approving the Cabinet Decision CA.61 in accordance with his delegated decision making emergency powers (as set out in the Constitution).
- 1.2 At the meeting held on 7 July 2020, Cabinet approved the following recommendation:-
  - "CA.61 That Cabinet approves and recommends to Council that:-
    - (1) the Future High Streets Fund Business Case for Northallerton is submitted to the Ministry of Housing Communities and Local Government; and
    - (2) a report be brought to Cabinet on the finalised capital and revenue costs."
- 1.3 The business case must be submitted to the Ministry of Housing Communities and Local Government by 30 July 2020 and successful bids will be announced at the end of September.
- 1.4 As the next scheduled meeting of Council is in September 2020, it is necessary to seek approval of the Deputy Chief Executive under his delegated decision making powers in order to ensure the business case to be submitted to the Ministry of Housing Communities and Local Government before the deadline of 30 July 2020.

## 2.0 Recommendation

2.1 That the Deputy Chief Executive is asked to consider the recommendations as detailed in Cabinet Minute CA.61, and detailed in paragraph 1.2 of the report, and use his delegated authority to approve the recommendations and agree to the submission of the business case to the Ministry of Housing Communities and Local Government by 30 July 2020.
