1.0 PURPOSE AND BACKGROUND:

1.1 To obtain Cabinet's approval to enter a funding agreement with Sport England in support of the Swim Local Pilot Project. Such an agreement is normal practice with this scale of external funding. The value of this fund is £274,525, and before these funds can be released the Council must meet the conditions set out in the Lottery Fund Agreement, including the following extract below:

The Applicant supplying Sport England with copies of resolutions or minutes (certified by an authorised officer) passed at a duly convened meeting of the Applicant's [councillors], in each case approving the entering into and execution of this Deed

2.0 LINK TO COUNCIL PRIORITIES:

- 2.1 The delivery of the project will improve the health and wellbeing of our people by providing and supporting community inclusive facilities, activities and interventions.
 - Increased swimming participation rates and therefore improve health
 - Reduction in health threatening conditions as a result of exercise
 - Improved health and wellbeing through swimming, initiatives, programmes and activities
 - Increased child safety through learning to swim
