CA.33 NORTHALLERTON SPORTS VILLAGE

All Wards

The subject of the decision:

A key component of the North Northallerton development was the concept of a sports village which would provide new opportunities for both formal organised sport and informal unsupervised recreation. A number of meetings had been held in recent years with sports clubs from Northallerton, Romanby and Brompton to explore development plans.
