Two reasons:- Noise.

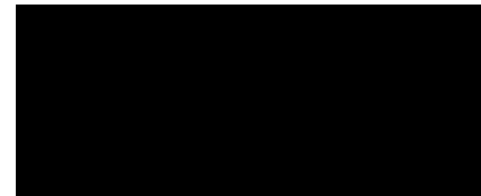

3. Conservation Area.

Both properties are within the Conservation Area. The change of use from a barn would appear to be a breach of the ethos of the Conservation status.

There is already a smoking/drinking area at the back of the pub & further late evening music, drinking (+ swearing) does not appear to enhance + preserve the character of the area.
